We can't hold back our excitement anymore! You're the first people we're telling SWIM LESSONS ARE COMING BACK TO REFRSHING MOUNTAIN!!

In addition to Swimming Lessons, we will be offering Lifeguard Certifications through the Red Cross in May/June. Details are on the back of this letter, but while we have your attention, here are some reminders of what makes a Refreshing Mountain Summer Pool Membership a positive experience.

- In 2018 we experimented with heating the pool water and it was successful! Since then we have refined how to keep the pool at a pleasant temperature. The pool temp is posted every 24-48 hours so you can check on it before leaving home!
- Our heart is to provide a family friendly, fun environment on our property. At the pool, this means that we strive to provide a pleasant and fun atmosphere which includes expecting our guests to wear modest swimming suits. For the females we ask that you limit the showing of cleavage or front/back midrift or simply put a dark tshirt on over your suit. For the males, we do not allow tight or short swimwear. Thank you for helping us to uphold this standard and understanding if a lifeguard asks you to wear a dark tshirt or different suit.
- Areas are designated for swimmers, nonswimmers and food consumption west the wide green lines on the pool entrance side. Please do not try and sneak food or talk the lifeguards into letting you past this point. Our goal is to provide a clean, hazard free environment where guards can easily distinguish who is swimming and who isn't.
- Parking for the pool is in Parking Lot B, beside the Dining Hall. Follow the blue painted swimmer icons to follow the pathway from the parking lot to the pool area. There are a few ADA spaces near the pool/store entrance.
- The 319Cafe will continue offering a variety of grilled panini options, coffee beverages, and ice cream and will now have indoor seating!

2020 Swimming Lessons

Members and guests alike can take advantage of group swimming lessons for children from ages 12 months to 12 years!!! To sign up, contact <u>Debbie@RefreshingMountain.com</u> to discuss which level your child should register for.

Group classes are as follows:

AquaTots (AT) – ages 12-36 months; maximum of 10 children *(Parent/adult much accompany child in the water)* Preschool (PS) – ages 3-5; PS Levels 1, 2, 3; maximum 10 children each level School Age (SA) – ages 6-12; SA Levels 1, 2, 3, 4; maximum 10 children each level

\$75 – must show proof of current American Red Cross certification prior to beginning of first class

*Prior to first Full Course class meeting, American Red Cross requires online registration and evidence of completion of approx. 7 hours of online study. At first class session, the American Red Cross requires ALL students to successfully complete an in-water skills screening and to present proof of age.

POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Any person may be barred from the pool area for violation of the rules and regulations at the discretion of those in charge.
- 2. Running, pushing, pulling, and rough play are not conducive to safety are prohibited in the pool and pool area.
- 3. Management reserves the right to limit the number of members/guests admitted, when in its opinion, the pool is overcrowded.
- 4. All persons in bathing attire shall wear a robe or appropriate covering on their way to and from swimming area. Swimwear must be a one piece suit for females and boxer style suits for males. ABSOLUTELY NO BIKINI OR SPEEDO SUITS ALLOWED. Normal clothing is allowed in pool area in the designated areas, however swimming attire will be required in the water. A dark tee shirt cover up can be used to cover a two piece suit. Tankinis are permissible if no midriff is exposed.
- Children, 10 years of age or under, are not permitted in the pool area without an adult. (Adult is defined as someone over the age of 18.)
- 6. Babies MUST be in swimming diapers while in the pool, No plastic diapers please!
- Admission can be refused to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eye infections or certain type of bandages.
 No pets allowed in pool area.
- 9. Food and beverages may be brought into the designated areas. No glass allowed in pool area. Dispose of leftovers properly. Please limit time at picnic tables so everyone can use as needed.
- 10. There is no admittance to the pool without a RM lifeguard on duty.
- 11. Voices are to be kept at a normal level. FOUL LANGUAGE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED!!! Personal music must be kept very personal.
- 12. Chairs and tables are first/come first/served. Please place towels and misc. items in the bins provided to keep the tables open for eating only, not lounging at.
- 13. No smoking allowed on the property of Refreshing Mountain unless in your vehicle.
- 14. No chewing gum or hard candy should be in the pool area.

- 15. Refrain from moving furniture around. Talk to Lifeguards if furniture needs to be rearranged and then put back in original location.
- 16. Pool membership at RM gives you access to the pool area and playground. It does not include access to other areas of the property. (i.e. the gyms, baseball field, pavilion, Ropes courses, etc.).
- 17. Family membership is defined as 2 married adults plus all dependent children. This includes fresh air/foster children but does not include relatives (grandparents, grandkids, cousins, etc.), unless such persons reside as a dependent with the family
