Kreider Farms:

Kreider Farms is a real working farm supplying fresh quality eggs, milk, drinks and premium batch-churned ice cream to select wholesalers and retail stores throughout the Mid-Atlantic region. Headquartered in Manheim, Pennsylvania, this third generation family owned and operated company is nestled in scenic Lancaster County, home of the most productive nonirrigated farmland in the country.

Fly down the giant tunnel slide or combine slide. Take the little ones for a trip around the Barnyard on a mini wagon ride. Race friends & family around the Pedal Kart track.
